TREASURER'S REPORT

The audited financial statements have already been presented to you and now I present to you the Treasurer's Report for the year 2022-23.

As I present the report for the year 2022-23, having gone through the Treasurer's Report for the year 2021-22, I must confess that I had sounded a little alarmist, however, with justification. Now that we are more or less out of the Covid-19 induced existential crisis, we now can breathe a little easier as the country has successfully weathered the crisis and it is 'business as usual'. There were some lessons learned at a great cost. We now know that we should not take anything for granted and going forward and it behoves us to act with caution without losing sight of our primary objective viz., 'Service to the Society' for which SPASTN was set up.

There are several signs visible that we are back on track. An indication of the turnaround is that, as compared to the previous year, the activities of SPASTN had resulted in a small surplus of Rs.15,32,044. I present below a summary of the financial results:

As stated in the earlier reports, there has been no support from the Government, either the State or the Central. SPASTN has therefore to rely on the donations and the tied-up donations from the corporate sector for continuing its operations.

The tied-up donations are project-specific and are usually, supported by the Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) outlays by companies and are vital to our continuing activities by the terms of the agreements with the donor-companies, the whole of the amounts are required to be spent on the projects without yielding any surplus to SPASTN.

Donations

Consequently, our reliance on donations without tie-ups continue. These donations as can be seen from the above summary were of the order of Rs.66.31 lakhs for the year as compared to Rs.46.77 lakhs in the previous year.

Expenditure on our core activity

The operating income for the year is Rs.123.88 lakhs as against Rs.74.40 lakhs. The operating expenditure against the heads is Rs.62.95 lakhs and Rs.56.01 lakhs. While at first sight, it appears that there is a surplus of Rs.60.93 lakhs, the realistic way of looking at it is that there is an expenditure of Rs.80.77 lakhs towards salaries and honorarium and depreciation amounting to Rs.64.80 lakhs. Therefore, it should be read as expenditure over income on our principal activity ranging between Rs.85 lakhs to Rs.90 lakhs.

One significant item of expenditure in the operating expenses is the expenditure related to the auditorium i.e. Therapeutic Enrichment Activity Hall - Research & Development [TEACH (R&D)] both on account of preventive, reactive maintenance and other value additions carried out for increase ease of use. During the year under review, there has been some interest expressed in hiring the auditorium by other organisations. We expect that, by the very nature of the purpose for which the auditorium was built, there would be a considerable amount of shortfall on the revenue generated and the expenditure on maintenance of it needs to be managed to ensure at least a breakeven to ensure the auditorium does not pinch the resources of the organisation.

Income and Expenditure

As regards the interest income earned, we have been discussing the rates of interest that the markets have been offering on our deposit. While the rate of interest has gone up in line with our expectations, the income is still more or less in line with the earlier years. Considering that the operating income has gone up and there is some surplus on account of it, together with the donations, we could expect some surplus every year whereby the deposit-base will grow year-on-year.

Growth in Investments

As mentioned earlier, there is a small operating surplus of Rs.15.32 lakhs, and together with depreciation of Rs.64.80 lakhs, the net cash inflow amounts to approximately Rs.80 lakhs. Taken with other adjustments, this has resulted in an increase in investments amounting to Rs.77 lakhs as disclosed in the balance sheet.

Information on Donors and Projects 2022-2023

I must go on record that once again, SPASTN has been supported by philanthropists by way of generous contributions. Many corporate have come forward to fund our activities as part of their CSR projects. In addition, we continue to receive support from donors in India and foreign organizations. I would like to acknowledge and record our appreciation for the fine gestures from the various sources.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT



I am pleased to present the Director's Report for the year 2022-23, a year that has been marked by resilience, compassion and meaningful impact. We have continued to place the everyday experiences disabled people at heart of everything we do.

8th May 2022 was a very sad day as we lost a stalwart in the field of Psychology and Special Education Prof. Jeyachandran. He was one of the founding members of SPASTN. We have lost both a trusted guide and compassionate person.

We have reached out to more than 3000 plus requests for information, guidance and support on matters related educational intervention, assessment, therapy, health insurance or guardianship both face-to-face and over phone.

As we reflect on our journey, we are reminded of the incredible strides we have made together as a team in our mission to support children and families with Cerebral Palsy, Multiple Disabilities, Autism Spectrum Disorder, Deafblindness and Intellectual Disabilities.

Programs and Services:

Through our 3 Centres at Taramani, Villivakkam [formerly Ayanavaram], Old Washermenpet and Community Based Rehabilitation across 6 blocks in Thiruvallur Districts we have provided comprehensive educational, including rehabilitation therapies, provided assistive, educational resources and emotional well-being activities.

Outreach and Awareness:

Through training workshops, volunteer engagement activities and community event campaigns were carried out namely child Safety, World Autism Awareness, Cerebral Palsy Day to name a few. We continue our work of advocating for the rights of children, families and breaking down barriers and challenging stereotypes associated with disabilities.

Collaborations and Partnerships:

SPASTN entered into a strategic partnerships with Chennai School of Music Therapy and ACS Medical college and Hospital[Deemed University] that runs undergraduate and post graduate, doctoral programs in physiotherapy for student internship placement.

I sit as an Expert Member on the State Advisory Board for the Differently Abled and as Technical Expert in Rehabilitation Council of India, National Institute for Persons with Multiple Disabilities. Sit as NGO member in the Prevention of Sexual Harassment Committee of National Institute of Fashion Technology, Department of Employment and Training, State Welfare Board. Expert Member of Regional Advisory Committee of National Institute of Open Schooling, NGO Head for Local Level Committee of the National Trust to name a few major committees.

Throughout the year we witnessed numerous successes when our children both on the Early Intervention program and other educational program achieved their developmental milestones in academic, social emotional, gross and fine motor, communication domains etc. When families share that they are experiencing improved quality of life both for themselves and in their children these stories inspire us to continuous vital work.

5 mothers of our students took the major leap to pursue 2year RCI approved Diploma program and they are going the extra mile to toggle pursuing education and managing the family including the child with disability. We have enrolled 3 students with hearing impairment for our Diploma Program in Teacher Training besides that a young adult with Cerebral palsy and Specific Learning Disability.

I acknowledge that the journey is not without challenges given the nature our beneficiaries who have to cope not only with disabilities but also the huge stress on their fragile socio-economic situation.

Our heartfelt gratitude goes out to our long-term donors, volunteers, CSR Partners and Department of DifferentlyAble for supporting us and our work.

Last but not the least is the support I receive from my Associate Director, Managers, Allied Health team, Educators and my administration team without whom my work is not possible. Thank all our stakeholders with deep sense of gratitude and I am hopeful of them being there to achieve our vision and mission.

Deafblind Unit – 17 + 13 = 30:

SPASTN started a separate unit at Old Washermenpet branch for children with deafblindness from 2015. At present SPASTN has 17 students in this unit. Early Intervention (0-6) group has 2 students, Primary and Pre vocational (6 – 18) group has 15. 20 parents joined in family network programme and 6 staffs joined in professional network programme. 13 severe db students are at Missionaries of Charity Shishubavan, Every Wednesday 1 special educator and one physiotherapist visit their homes and provide need based intervention. Home based programme for Ahson and Fazhil with 1 special educator and 1 physiotherapist visit 2 times in a month. .

There are 21 students attending this group. 5 Students in Early Intervention group, 2 students studying in regular school. 10 students attending in bridge group. 15 non verbal students communicate with their Picture cards and basic sign language. Brain gym, Aerobics, Yoga, Relaxation, Drawing, Special education, Communication, Sensory integration, Music, Circle time activities, Play ground activities and Silambam class, shopping skills followed in this group. Master. Yoseph, Master. Nesanraj, Master. Priyan from this class participated in inter school competitions like Singing, Music and Silambam, Puzzle etc. and won prizes.

Early Intervention Programme:19 students (1-6 years of age):

Play way method of teaching was introduced to the Early Intervention Group. All the students underwent medical intervention like Visual Screening, Auditory Screening and Neurological evaluation. They are getting physiotherapy , sensory integration, speech therapy, counseling and guidance. Introduced Singing, dancing, pre-writing skill, coloring work, Sitting tolerance, Activities for daily living and Attention span increasing activities are given. 2 students from this group are attending Balvadi.

Primary Class: 21 students

From this group 1 student is studying in regular school. Focus on Literacy, Communication, fine motor skills, social emotional activities (story telling, puppet play), Music therapy, Aerobics, Brain gym, Yoga and Relaxation activities Sports activities and Computer class. Future plan to send 2 students to Skill training unit. In this group Diyya Dharshini and Aasini participated in the interschool drawing and dance competition and won 2nd prize.

Skill Training Unit:

There are 29 students in this group. 13 Boys and 16 girls are studying in this class. Both have separate class rooms. They are getting Special Education, Physiotherapy, Sensory integration, Communication, Time, Money, ADL Skills, Privacy and Sex education, Leisure time activities like dusting, cleaning of vessels, cooking and washing clothes, Shopping skill, Drawing and Painting,

Dance, Sports & Craft work. Started Artificial Jewelry like Bangle, Chain, Earring and Chocolate making etc. 3 students from this group studying in regular school. Plan to send 5 students to Taramani for Vocational Skilling Program.

- Ms. G.Swetha, Ms. Shameera Sofia and Master. Shivkumar selected for National Badminton event from our state.

March 28th to March 31st National Badminton competition held at Goargan, Hariyana, Ms. Shameera got 4th place and Ms. Swetha got 6th place in National level.
