My brother is just two years younger than me. When I was young, I didn't know about his disability and thought that all brothers would be like him crying. It took me ten years to realize that he is autistic. My parents were getting many complaints about him from school, neighbors and family. So, initially, I was hesitant to talk about my brother to my friends. I used to play with and care for him but won't share anything about him with my friends. Whenever anyone talks about spending time with their siblings, I used to feel that my family was different. My parents and I hoped that he would become normal one day. It took me many years to realize that my brother needed a different type of support to reach his potential. So, I started to accept him as he was. Acceptance of Dinesh opened a new perspective about him. Whenever I was sad, I never express it but my brother had this very amazing ability to sense my emotions and console me saying, " Don't worry! I am there". There are so many examples like this that made me feel that he is a noble soul. Slowly, I started to respect him. He had so many talents but could not express them. Till then my brother was studying in inclusive schools. Later, we got him admitted to the SPASTN. That was the time that I met several children with disabilities and their families. I was able to relate my parent's experience with many other parents. After joining the school, both my mother and brother were at peace as if they reached their home. He met and interacted with so many parents. Now, he is 21. He showed the maturity of someone about 15 years of age. I wish to have him by my side after my marriage and be there for him. He loves going to temples and hearing bhajans. In future, I wish him to be with me and ensure he reaches his fullest potential. After all these experiences with him, I have a goal in my life. It is building an organization that serves families with specially-disabled children in all possible ways. At last, my brother whom I was hesitating to even talk about has turned out to be a role model and inspiration for me to be a good human being. He is now representing Tamil Nadu State in Swimming and setting the pools on fire with his strokes. I thank God for giving me a wonderful journey of knowing my brother who is so kind and caring. She started showing interest in dance when as a three year old and was encouraged to participate in various dance events by her teachers and parents. Though flat footed she confidently dances to any rhythm as dancing makes her feel joyful. Her love for dance has helped her balance her body and move gracefully to any music. Seeing Loshika's interest in dance her mother did not give up and enrolled her into classical Dance form.

Loshika is a trained Bharathanatyam dancer. She is undergoing training at Chitralaya Kalai Koodam dance school under the able guidance of her aunt and teacher Mrs. Chitra Vadivel. Her teacher fondly calls her "Loshi" and believes that Loshi is "God's child". Her teacher notes that "She overcame her challenges with constant hard work and now can perform mudras and foot movements with ease"

Loshika has performed on stage along with her normal peers at Ekambareshwara Temple festival, Parry's corner and Narayana Mandir, Doveton. With this confidence Loshika gushes "Dancing excites me"!



Awareness to Empowerment

During one of the visits from Padianallur to Avadi by our team for an awareness campaign, we met a group of people sitting under the banyan tree after completing the days work. Further quizzing them, we found that they were employed under The Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme initiative of the Govt. of India. Our discussions led to one of them quickly leading and introducing us to a couple among them whose son had difficulties in speech.

Vennila, mother of 5 year old Tamilselvan narrated her ordeal of raising him with no support or intervention from anyone. As Vennila started pouring out her fears and anxieties she knew her child had delayed milestones but did not know how and who to turn to. Her husband Baskar brought their son to us to see. Our staff reassured and gave some early guidance in working with their child. The family was encouraged to come to Padianallur CBR.

At Padianallur CBR, Tamilselvan was assessed and was given intervention. He showed significant improvement after undergoing speech therapy, motor training and special education at our centre. Today Vennila warmly reflects the times when family members were not kind in their observations regarding Tamilselvan and now they are very happy to observe the changes in him. Tamilselvan dreams to become a Policeman one day. SPASTN wishes to be part of his dreams!
